### Abstract

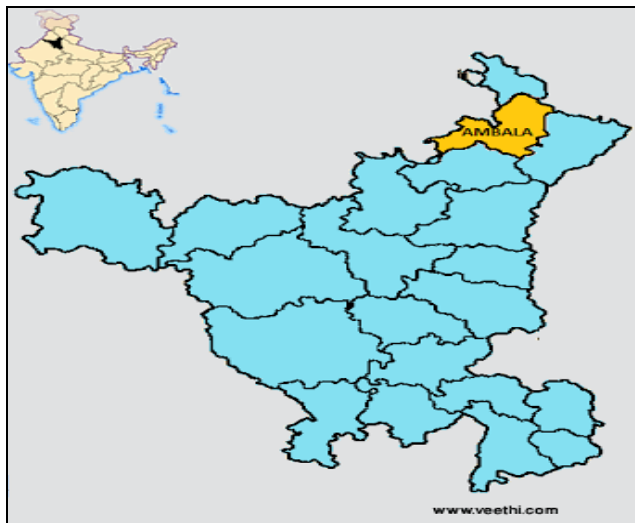

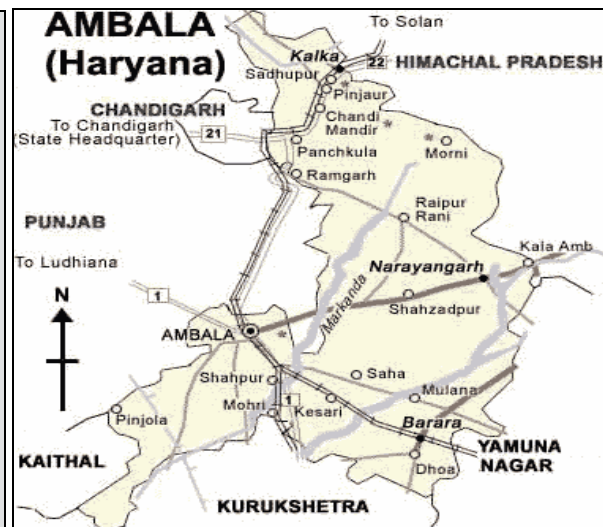


Fig 2: Map of Ambala District

Ambala separates the Ganges network from the Indus network and is encircled by 2 rivers – Ghaggar and Tangri – to the north and to the south. Thanks to its geographical location, the Ambala district plays a very important role in native business, being situated forty-seven-kilometer (28 miles) south of Chandigarh, the metropolis, 148-kilometer (93 miles) southwest of Shimla, 198-kilometer (121 miles) north of latest metropolis and 260-kilometer (155 miles) southeast of Amritsar. Gurudwara Manji European is additionally located in Ambala. It's aforesaid that Ambala District was supported by Amba Rajpoot throughout the ordinal century. Another version is that the name could be a corruption of Amba Wala that means the mango-village, from mango groves that existed in its immediate neighborhood.
